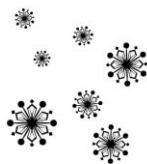

Both Official Entry Applications must be filled out and returned to the Winterfest office by 5:00 p.m. DECEMBER 1, 2019. *PLEASE NOTE THAT ANY APPLICATIONS NOT RECEIVED BY THIS DEADLINE WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED COMMENTARY IN THE TELEVISION SPECIAL.

Applications received at the Captain's Meeting on the December 10th will be accepted and forwarded – but television/radio commentary is NOT guaranteed.

Remember this information is used for the television commentary – be descriptive!!!!

REMINDER: Please keep in mind that in the eyes of a child there is ONLY ONE SANTA CLAUS.

Only one boat will be allowed to host a live Santa Claus which is boat #100 - therefore, any vessel (other than the one designated by Winterfest) with a live Santa Claus or person with a Santa Hat and beard will NOT be permitted to participate the parade.
